Once a year, our bishop asks each of us to make a commitment to support the work of our diocesan programs and ministries that provide services that no on parish provide on its own. This effort is a means by which we can all work together to care for the Church by sharing the gifts God has granted us. Our parish goal is 100% participation. Our parish goal is \$14,680.00.
